| MATERIAL | WHAT TO RECYCLE | HOW TO RECYCLE | DO NOT INCLUDE |

| <p>GLASS - CLEAR</p>  | <p>Clear bottles and jars.</p> | <p>Rinse clean. REMOVE all metal or plastic CAPS and RINGS Labels may be left on Place each separate color glass in a separate Brown Paper Bag.</p> | <p>No light bulbs, dishes, ceramics, mirrors, pyrex, window glass, drinking glass, windshields</p> <p>No colored glass</p> |
| <p>PLASTIC</p>  <p>JUGS ONLY</p>  | <p>Milk and water jugs Bleach bottles Colored detergent</p> <p>Look for the Code 2 symbol on the bottom</p> <p>JUGS AND BOTTLES only (large bottom & small top)</p> | <p>REMOVE all metal or plastic CAPS and RINGS. Drain anti-freeze containers well Rinse other containers clean Labels may be left on PLEASE FLATTEN CONTAINERS!!! Place in Brown Paper Bags</p> | <p>No Plastic bags No plastic or metal caps and rings No bottles which are clear and glossy (soft drink, cooking oil, peanut butter) No butter tubs, coolwhip tubs, pails or toys. NO OIL CONTAINERS REMEMBER- NO CAPS!!!</p> |
| <p>TIN CANS AND ALUMINUM</p>  | <p>Aluminum cans, pie plates, trays and CLEAN aluminum foil. Tin cans and lids Coffee, soup, vegetables, tuna, fruit cans, pet food cans (just to name a few)</p> | <p>Rinse clean and REMOVE LABELS Remove at least one end, place lid inside, crush open end PLEASE FLATTEN CONTAINERS Place in brown paper bags</p> | <p>No aerosol cans, paint cans, metal caps and covers</p> |
| <p>NEWSPAPER TELEPHONE BOOKS MAGAZINES</p>  | <p>Newspapers - including all the glossy supplements that come with the paper Magazines and catalogs with GLOSSY covers Inside pages may be glossy or non-glossy</p> | <p>Place LOOSE in brown paper bags DO NOT TIE WITH STRING</p> | <p>No string, junk mail, office or computer paper. NO CORRUGATED CARDBOARD</p> |
| <p>CORRUGATED CARDBOARD</p>  | <p>Only CORRUGATED cardboard containers BROWN PAPER GROCERY BAGS ARE ALSO ALLOWED</p> | <p>Boxes should be clean dry and FLAT Remember FLATTEN CONTAINERS Please remove staples, tape and plastic mailing labels</p> | <p>No cereal, pizza, egg or shoe boxes, milk and six-pack containers and wax coated cardboard. No "yellow cardboard" Please remove staples, tape, plastic mailing labels</p> |
| <p>MIXED PAPER</p>  | <p>Junk mail, cereal boxes, letters, folders, white and colored paper and bags, cards, postcards, calendars, checks, envelopes, other food and paperboard boxes and soda cartons Milk and juice cartons, drink boxes, frozen food containers.</p> | <p>Rinse milk and juice cartons, drink boxes, frozen food containers and let dry. Place loose in brown paper bags</p> | <p>NO Magazines No foil or glitter paper products NO FOOD-CONTAMINATED PAPER OR PAPERBOARD PRODUCTS (PIZZA BOXES, ETC.)</p> |

Plastic shopping bags from Hannaford and other stores can be recycled at the entrance to those stores. Do not include them with your curbside recyclables.
