Individuals can take material (both trash and recycling) to Norridgewock Transfer Station for disposal. Recycling at Norridgewock Transfer Station is a "single stream" facility – all recyclables except cardboard can be mixed together; cardboard goes in a separate bin. A Sticker for your car is required and can be purchased for \$2.50 from the Town Clerk. The hours of operation at Norridgewock are:

Wed. - Fri. 9:30 a.m. - 6 p.m., Sat. 7:30 a.m. - 4 p.m. (closed Sunday-Tuesday)

Telephone: 207-634-2714 Entrance is on the Airport Road in Norridgewock - NOT on Rt. 2.

NOTE: **No** trailers are allowed to unload at the Norridgewock Transfer Station.

Recycling Reminders:

- **Curbside Recycling: PLEASE SEPARATE**
glass – clear **and** colored; metal cans; newspaper, mixed paper, magazines & brochures, books; plastic – all types except Styrofoam; flattened cardboard.
- **BULKY Recycling: Dates in 2017 are May 8 July 17, October 9**
Metal, appliances, brown goods, car-sized tires (3 per household, must be dismantled from rims), **NO** demolition debris
Universal Waste: please separate these items from the other material
Electronic equipment (computers, VCRs, TVs, copiers, printers, etc.)
Propane tanks
Fluorescent bulbs, CFL bulbs
Batteries (all types)
Thermostat, and thermometers containing mercury

NOTE: it is best to take your small technology items to Staples or Best Buy (see below) to ensure recycling; During curbside pickup, they may be overlooked and put into the trash.
- **Norridgewock Transfer Station:** You will need a sticker available from the Town Clerk. Please Remember – **NO** trailers are allowed at the Norridgewock Transfer Station; use a car, pickup truck or van.

All demolition debris can be taken to Norridgewock Transfer Station. Shingles do NOT have to be separated.

Recycling at the Transfer Station is single-stream; only cardboard is separate
Universal waste (see above)
- **Other Recycling Options for Electronic Technology products:**

Staples:
Return used ink jet cartridges and receive a credit toward future purchases
Rechargeable batteries
“Technology” recycling: electronic equipment, peripherals, calculators, GPS devices, digital cameras, camcorders, cordless phones, cell phones (see <http://www.staples.com/sbd/cre/marketing/easy-on-the-planet/recycling-and-eco-services.html> for more details.

Best Buy:
Rechargeable batteries
“Technology” recycling: electronic equipment, peripherals, calculators, GPS devices, digital cameras, camcorders, cordless phones, cell phones (see <http://www.bestbuy.com/site/Global-Promotions/Recycling-Electronics/pcmcat149900050025.c?id=pcmcat149900050025> for more details.
- **Disposal of Unused/Expired Medications**
Various law enforcement offices (Sheriff, State Police, Town Police) can accept unused medications. Contact them for information about protocol for dropping them off.
- **Reuse Amazon boxes**
Fill boxes received from Amazon with donations for Goodwill (clothes, home good products, accessories), seal up, create a free shipping label from the service [GiveBackBox](#), and drop it off at a USPS or UPS. The box will automatically be sent to the nearest participating Goodwill – no cost to you.
