FOR THE PURPOSES OF A BURIAL PLACE, a certain lot or parcel of land situated in the new part of the Village Cemetery, in said Vienna, bounded and described as follows, to wit:-

Commencing on the southerly side of the road leading to said Cemetery from Route No. 41, at the northwesterly corner of the cemetery lot of Gary White; thence easterly on the northerly side of said White lot, fourteen (14') feet; thence northerly parallel with said road leading to said Cemetery, nine (9') feet; thence westerly parallel with the first mentioned bound fourteen (14') feet to said Cemetery road; thence southerly on the easterly side of said Cemetery road nine (9) feet to the point of beginning.

Us here and in full the same, together with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging to them the said Merton Hall and Esther Hall, their

Heirs and Assigns forever.
