- Lot "I" is expected to be established by an exchange of deeds by which lot "20" will be extinguished and thus in effect relocated.

### LOCATIONS of PROPOSED LOTS "101" through "191"

Lots 101 - 145, 147, 150 - 163, 167 - 178, 180 - 191 are rectangular lots measuring 9' 0" x 6' 8" and located as shown.

Lots 148, 149, 165, and 166 are somewhat irregular, forming common corners with previously laid out lots (as shown).

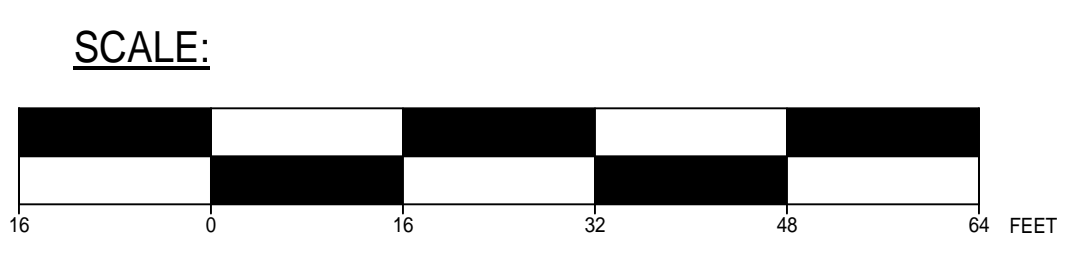
The northerly sides of lots 146, 164, and 179 are 9.0 feet long and extend at right angles to the cemetery parcel perimeter boundary (as shown).
