

The following family size and income levels qualify for the Federal Internet Subsidy under the Affordable Connectivity Program. Your family qualifies if double your household income is in the 200% column.

For the 48 Contiguous States and Washington, DC

1	\$12,800	\$25,760
2	\$17,420	\$34,840
3	\$21,960	\$43,920
4	\$26,500	\$53,000
5	\$31,290	\$62,580
6	\$35,580	\$71,160

Larger household sizes also qualify at 200% of household income levels.
